Revised Constitution Effective January 1965

Articel VIII, Nominations and Elections of Officers

- Section I ^{committee elected} Nominating shall be chosen at the regular membership meeting in March.
- Section 3^{1st} Officers shall be elected at the April meeting of Sisterhood
- Section 3. Installation of officers shall take place in May, at either a regular meeting or an open social function.
- Section 4 Any vacancy in office shall be filled by the executive committee. *hand 77*
- Section 5 ^{4 weeks prior to the monthly meeting} The Nominating Committee shall consist of seven (7) members, four (4) from the Board of Directors; and three (3) from the general membership. The member of this committee receiving the highest number of votes, shall be the chairman. This committee shall report at the meeting prior to the annual meeting. ~~the slate~~ shall be mailed with the notice of the annual meeting. Nominations shall be called for from the floor at the ^{april} meeting. The past presidents shall serve on this committee in an advisory capacity, without voting privileges.
- Section 6 ^{sec. 3} The officers shall be elected at each annual meeting in April. In the event of no opposing candidates, the secretary shall be authorized to cast an unanimous ballot. *3rd*
- ~~Section 7. The nominating committee shall be elected by the general membership at the March meeting; and shall present and elect the slate at the regular meeting in April; and the officers shall be installed in May.~~
- Section 8 ⁵ The term of office of the officers shall be for one (1) year, and they may be re-elected two more consecutive terms. No woman is eligible for office in this organisation until she has been a member in good standing for one year. *Any vacancy in office shall be filled by the*
- Section 9 ⁶ A vice-president takes office with the understanding that she will eventually accept the presidency, if elected. Nominations for this office will also be made from the floor at the regular nominating meeting. *In the event of some unforeseen circumstance the pres. cannot continue her term of office*
- Article VII, Board of Directors *the 1st V.P. shall assume the office of President.*
- Section 1. Five (5) members in good standing of the organization

shall be elected to the Board of Directors each year. The Nominating Committee shall present the Board of Directors to the general membership along with the rest of the slate.

Section 2. The term of service for elected directors shall be three (3) years.

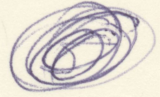
Section 3. The elected members of the Board, together with the chairmen of committees shall constitute the Board of Directors.

Section 4. Any board member who misses three consecutive meetings (Regular or Board), during the year, except for unavoidable reasons, shall be automatically dropped from the Board. Notice to this effect shall first be sent by the Recording Secretary, after the second consecutive absence. The President shall be empowered to appoint a new Board Member to serve for the unexpired term.
