The board voted unanimously to approve the recommendation of the Social Planning and Budgeting Committee that the United Jewish Federation endorse and sponsor the application to the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development by Beacon Housing Corporation for 75 Unit high rise apartment for the elderly and handicapped to be erected in the 14th ward, city of Pgh.

A second motion was passed, the same as above, with

the only difference being a 26 unit five story apartment (instead of the 75 as stated earlier)

WOARD VOTED UNANIMOUSLY to approve resolution that UJF endorse and sponsor application to the U.S. Dept. of Housing for Beacon Towers Housing Corp. for 101 unit high-rise apartment for elderly and handicapped.
