PLANNING COMMITTEE REPORT TO BOARD RE (1) MONEY TO BE ALLOCATED TO MONTEFIORE HOSPITAL AND YM&WHA MORTGAGES ARE THE SOLE PRIORITY IN THE CAMPAIGN FOR THE TOTAL AMT. OF CHARGES: (2) ALL OTHER BENEFICIARIES TO GET PERCENTAGE OF AMT. RAISED, INCLUDING MONTEFIORE CAPITAL FUND, WHICH IS TO HAVE CEILING OF \$250,000, FUND OBLIGATION OF \$1,000,000 IF NOT PAID IN 1949, 1950, 1951, 1952, TO BE PAID OVER YEAR OR TWO FOLLOWING: (3) COST OF LOCAL REFUGEE CARE TO BE MET ON TWO YEAR BASIS AND ANY AMT. SPENT IN 1950 OVER AND BEYOND PERCENTAGE ARRANGEMENT TO BE CHARGED TO 1951 CAMPAIGN.
