It was the consensus of the Officers that the Federation approve in principle its participation in this program, with funds provided on a last dollar basis to a limit of three students per semester for the first two years, with the understanding that if additional students wish to participate in the program, that the schools would have the opportunity to make an additional presentation to the Federation at that time. It

was agreed that costs would be limited to a maximum of \$7,500 per student and that this recommendation would be presented to the Social Planning & Budgeting Committee and ultimately to the Federation Board of Directors for its action prior to any communication with the schools.

Voted by Board to approve request of American Friends of Hebrew University to conduct a campaign for capital funds in amount of \$75,000 in months of September and October, 1960 to a limited number of people in closed meetings.
