NEW AMERICANS RESETTLEMENT COMMITTEE-

Dean Hirschfield

Established in response to large influx of New Americans from Russia.

Through the efforts of Mark Talisman of CJF IN Wash. , a \$16,000,000 matching fund Block Grant issued by Health, Education & Welfare has been made available to the local Jewish Communities for the resettlement of the Russians who arrive between October 1, 1978 and September 30, 1979, covering two thirds of each Community's quote. The HEW contract requires that

a sum equal to the Federal funds be provided as a match. Therefore, each community must spend \$2,000 per person in order to recover \$1,000.
