

TAHARAS MISHPOCHA

A very interesting and well attended meeting took place at the Poale Zedeck Snyagogue on Monday evening, November 10th. Rabbi S. B. Friedman, as Chairman, explained in his introductory remarks that the meeting was called for the purpose of discussing the subject of Taharas Mishpocha (Purity of Jewish Family Life).

The chairman then called upon Rabbis Sivitz, Kochin, Leiter and Horowitz for remarks. The main address of the evening was delivered by Rabbi Dr. Leo Jung, of the Jewish Center, New York City.

Dr. Jung is one of the most prominent Orthodox Rabbis of the country. He is the author of the book entitled "Foundations of Judaism", a pamphlet on "The Essentials of Judaism", and a contributor of note to the leading American Jewish journals and magazines. The subject of Taharas Mishpocha was most interestingly and inspiringly presented by Rabbi Jung, from both a religious and scientific point of view, in English and German.

Rabbi Friedman suggested that an organization be formed immediately

to promote the cause of "Taharas Mishpocha". The following officers were then elected temporarily: President, Jacob Gold; Secretary, Israel Cohen; Treasurer, Max Engelberg; Board of Directors, Isadore Unger, H. Beeson, H.
