The Torah, or the Pentateuch, is the beautiful handprinted scrolb of the Five Books of Moses. These books make up the Book of Law, the first section of the Old Testament in the Bible.

The Torag is kept in the Art of the symagorus. Each Sabbeth a portion of the Torah is read during worship. Each week the reading is started where the previous reader stopped reading. Now the Torah is divided into about fifty sections and the entire Torah can be read

in about a year.

The Books of Moses are given the mass the Book of Law because they contain the leave of the hebrews, the Constitution of Juddain. The ancient people were taught their religious laws such as the laws of accrifices and the dates and observances of their holidays. They were also taught their political laws, the taxes the law of the properties of officers, and also their business laws.

The books contained in the Torah are: Genesis, Exodus,

Leviticus, Numbers, Deuteromomy.
