In Re Petition of the Anshe Sward Galicia Congregation of the City of McKeesport, Penna,  
for a Charter of Incorporation.

In the Court of Common Pleas No. 2 of Allegheny County, Pa.,  
No. 4 April Term, 1898;

To the Honorable, the Judges of the Court of Common Pleas No. 2 of Allegheny County, Pa.,

In compliance with the requirement of an Act of the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, entitled, "An act to provide for the incorporation and regulation of certain corporations," approved the 20th day of April, 1874, and the supplements thereto, the undersigned, three, at least of whom are citizens of Pennsylvania, having associated themselves together for the purpose of the support of public worship in accordance with the Galician Ritual of the Hebrew Faith and belief, and desiring that they may be incorporated according to law, do hereby certify:

First: Name,

The name of the proposed corporation is The Anshe Sward Galicia Congregation of the City of McKeesport, County of Allegheny, State aforesaid; said words, "Anshe Sward Galicia," translated into the English language mean, "Persons praying according to the Galician Ritual of the Hebrew Faith."

Second: Purpose,

Said corporation is formed for the purpose of the support of public worship according to the faith, doctrine, discipline and usages of the Hebrew Faith or creed in accordance with the Galician Ritual or method of prayer of said creed or faith.

Third: Place of business,

The business of said corporation is to be transacted in the City of McKeesport, in the County of Allegheny and State of Pennsylvania.

Fourth: Existence,

Said corporation is to exist perpetually.

## Fifth: Officers and Trustees,

The number of officers and trustees of said corporation is fixed at seven, to wit, a president, vice-president, secretary and treasurer and three trustees, all together composing the directory of said congregation; the majority of whom shall be lay members and the names and residences of those who are chosen officers and trustees for the first year are as follows:-

## Sixth: Income,

The yearly income of this corporation, other than that derived from real estate shall, not exceed the sum of Ten Thousand Dollars. This incorporation is to receive its support and maintenance from voluntary contribution, donations and from monthly dues payable by the members which is now fixed at \$1.30 per month, payable by each member. This corporation was organized in November, 1897, for the purposes set forth in the second paragraph of this application, it now has thirty-five members and has since the time of its organization maintained a place of worship on Market Street in the City of McKeesport, aforesaid.

## Seventh: Property,

Any property, real or personal, which shall hereafter be bequeathed, devised or conveyed to said corporation shall be taken and held, or ensue to it, subject to the control and disposition of the lay members thereof, or such constituted officers or representatives thereof as shall be composed of a majority of lay members.
