

SPECIAL CONGREGATIONAL MEETING, TUESDAY, AUGUST 30, 1977

The meeting was called to order by the president, Donald Cohen for the purpose of amending the By-Laws of the constitution concerning Article IV, Section I involving the minimum dues structure.

ARTICLE IV, SECTION I

For the purpose of raising the revenue necessary for the maintenance of the congregation there shall be a system of dues that shall make it possible for everyone to become a member and necessary for all to contribute a fair share. The Board of Directors shall have the authority to determine the amount of dues of each member.

The above motion was moved by Henry Ekker and seconded by Fredric Leeds. The motion passed by 58 ayes to 4 nays.

ARTICLE IV, SECTION I PRESENTLY READS

For the purpose of raising the revenue necessary for the maintenance of the congregation, there shall be a system of dues that shall make it possible for everyone to become a member, and necessary for all to contribute a just share. The amount of the dues shall be set by majority vote at a regular meeting of the membership of the congregation.
