Dear Sherman,

The Congregation B'nai Israel of Glassport has sold the synagogue and its contents, so with part of the proceeds, we must buy additional grave plots from the M. E. Keesport Temple, as every paid up member, as of the closing date of the sale is entitled to free ground if they desire it.

Because we only wish to purchase the amount of needed ground, we are asking all members if they intend to exercise their right to this ground. We also want to remind all members, that according to the by-laws, this ground is not transferable, and if not used, reverts back to the Congregation B'nai Israel.

With any money that may remain from the sale of the Schul, we are purchasing perpetual care for all plots that the congregation has or will purchase.
