THIS INDENTURE

Made the Eleventh day of March in the
year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty - Six between
the Canonsburg Hebrew Association of the Tree of Life Synagogue,
a Corporation under the Laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
having its domicile in the Borough of Canonsburg, County of
Washington, in the said Commonwealth party of the first part,
and Samuel Finkel, same Borough, County
and State,

party of the second part;

Witnesseth, that the said party of the first part, for and in
consideration of the sum of One Hundred and Fifty
(\$150.00) Dollars, lawful money of the United
States of America, to said Corporation in hand paid by the said
party of the second part, at or before the sealing and delivery
of the presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
has granted, bargained, sold and conveyed and by these presents
does grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said party of the
second part his heirs and assigns. All those three (3) seats
in the Tree of Life Synagogue, located in the Borough of
Canonsburg, Washington County, Pa. and described as follows:-
Seats Nos. 8 and 9 on the first floor and
Seat No.36 in the balcony.

To have and to hold the said seats hereditaments and premises hereby granted, or mentioned and intended so to be with appurtenances, unto the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns, to and for the only proper use and behoof of the said party of the second part his assigns forever.

It is hereby agreed between the said parties, that this deed is made subject to rules, regulations and constitution of the said party of the first part, Canonsburg Hebrew Association of the Tree of Life Synagogue.

In witness whereof, the said corporation, party of the first part has caused its common and corporate seal to be affixed to these presents by the hand of its President and the same to be duly attested by its Secretary, the day and year first above written.
