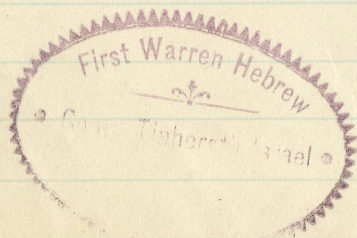

June 16, 1918

The meeting was called to order by President W. Rothchild at 8:00 P. M. The Sec's menace were read and approved.

The President reported that the deal with the U. B. Cong. has been closed and the former property became the Synagogue of the Warren Hebrew Cong.

Geo. Waxman of the Building Comm. reported that the said committee inspected the building and their opinion is that the building cannot be used as a real orthodox Synagogue. Unless it should be changed certain walls and a special ladies entrance should be built, also painted and decorated. After a short discussion of the members they gave the power of the said committee they shall repair according to their understandings.

Mr. H. Sontag made a motion of taxing each member of taxing each member 50¢ a month to cover the expense of the Syn. and all the members were in its favor.

All the the members present paid their due tax in advance excepting Mr. J. S. Brown paid for 1 yr. in advance.
