Gentlemen:

A meeting was held by members of The Tree of Life Synagogue, New York Avenue and Pinney Street, Rochester, Pennsylvania on May 9th, 1973. At this meeting, it was decided and agreed that all assets of the Tree of Life Congregation be turned over to the Beaver Falls United Jewish Community Center. In exchange for this turn-over, the membership asked that the following considerations be allowed to them:

1. That the Ben Reichberg Memorial Tablet be placed on a wall in the sanctuary and be properly maintained.
2. That the current Tree of Life members be allowed membership for one (1) year with full membership privileges to Agudath Achia Congregation which would include burial plots for husband and wife.
 - a. All members who maintained dual membership to both Tree of Life and Agudath Achia to have membership extended for one (1) full year.

The above offerings to apply if they so desire.

3. That full ownership of cemetery grounds located in Marion Hill, Polish Township, New Brighton, Pennsylvania also be turned over to U. J. C. C.

We ask that you confirm the above agreements in writing to all of the concerned members of the Tree of Life Congregation, Rochester, Pennsylvania.
