In Re Charter of the Base Abraham Congregation
 Amendment. In the Court of Common Pleas
 No. 1 of Allegheny County, Penna.
 No. 466 March Term, 1889.

To the Honorable, the Judges of the said Court:

The Base Abraham Congregation hereby certifies under its corporate seal, that it is a corporation created and existing under the Corporation Act of One Thousand Eight Hundred and seventy-four and its supplements, as is shown by its charter dated the 25th day of January 1889, a true copy of which is herewith submitted; that it is included in the class of corporations referred to in Section 42, Corporation Act of One Thousand Eight Hundred and seventy-four and its supplements. That in pursuance of said corporate actions duly had, it is desirous of improving and amending or altering the articles and conditions of its said charter in accordance with the provisions of the said last recited Act in the following particulars, that is to say:-

First:- Said corporation shall have the right to purchase real estate not in excess of the amount allowed by law, for the purpose of establishing a cemetery where the bodies of the deceased members of said congregation or any member of their families may be interred.

Second:- Any property, real or personal which shall hereafter or herebefore have been or be bequeathed, devised, or conveyed to said corporation, shall be taken and held over and to it, subject to the control and disposition of the lay members thereof, or such constituted officers or representatives, as shall be composed of a majority of lay members.

Wherefore, the Base Abraham Congregation prays that the said amendments may be approved, and, upon compliance with the provisions of said Act, be deemed and taken to be a part of its charter.

In Testimony Whereof, the corporate seal of the Base Abraham Congregation has been hereto affixed and duly attested this 5th day of July, 1904.

Order of Court

And now, to wit, August 6th 1904 the within certificate having been presented, and it appearing that the Order of Court heretofore made had been duly complied with, it is therefore ordered and decreed that upon the recording of the said certificate with its instruments and this decree in the Office of the Recorder of Deeds in and for said County which is now hereby ordered said improvements, amendments, or alterations shall be deemed and taken to be a part of the charter of the Base Abraham Congregation
