Dear Sir:-

At a meeting of the Board of Directors of the J. M. Gusky Orphanage and Home, held on the 9th inst., your proposition to endow the institution with the sum of Five thousand dollars (conditioned first upon the acceptance of Mr. Aaron Cohen's gift of Ten thousand dollars under the conditions set forth by him; second, that the said sum be called The Louis I. Aaron's and his wife Mina's Endowment to the Bertha Rauh-Cohen Memorial; third, that a separate account thereof be kept in the ledger of our institution and that said endowment fund be kept permanent and be invested in no other than first bond and mortgage real estate securities, and the interest realized therefrom be applicable to defray the general expenses of our institution as a whole) was unanimously adopted, subject to the said conditions.

And further, that at a special meeting of the members of the association called for that purpose, the said action of the Board of Directors was unanimously ratified on the 21st inst.
