IN ORDER TO MAKE A JUSTIFIABLE COMPARISON WITH THE RECEIPTS AND DISBURSEMENTS OF PREVIOUS YEARS - WHEN THE EMMA FARM ASSOCIATION RECEIVED THE MONIES DIRECT FROM THE VARIOUS WELFARE ORGANIZATIONS, INSTEAD OF FOOD ORDER CREDITS AS THIS YEAR 1933 - THE AMOUNT OF THE FOOD ORDER CREDITS FOR 1933, TOTALLING \$541.80, HAS BEEN ADDED TO TRANSPORTATION RECEIPTS OF \$2882.45, THUS INCREASING SAME TO \$3424.25; AND ALSO ADDED TO FOOD DISBURSEMENTS, THUS INCREASING SAME FROM \$4497.23 TO \$5039.03; THUS INCREASING REAL RECEIPTS FROM \$18,443.83 TO \$18,985.63 AND REAL DISBURSEMENTS FROM \$18,388.59 TO \$18,930.39.

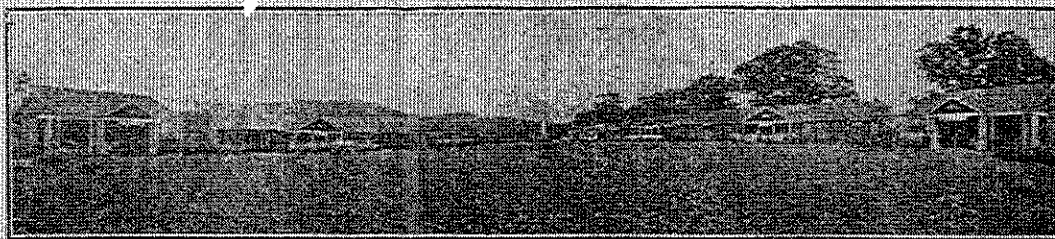

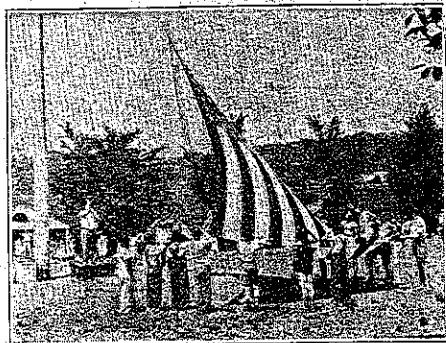
