Gentlemen:-

The Jewish War Veterans of the United States have launched a campaign to secure one million signatures to a petition against American participation in the Olympic games of 1936, if held in Germany.

We are sending you petitions, which we ask that your members sign individually. We feel that the members of your organization as well as every right thinking American are opposed to American participation in the Olympic games, if held in Germany, for the reason that the present rulers of Germany, by their persecution and oppression of Protestants, Jews, Catholics, Liberals, Labor Unionists, Veterans Organizations, Masons and other groups, have shown a thorough lack of understanding of the principles of equality and fair play.

We ask that you appoint your committees immediately, so that they can go to work. Make every man responsible for the number of petitions he secures.

"Speed" is the watchword.

These petitions should be filled out and returned before November 1st, to the Jewish War Veterans, care of Y. M. & W. H. A., Pittsburgh, Pa.
