

Schaffer Pays Tribute To Canteen Volunteers

“The nation-wide fame which our Canteen has achieved was due chiefly to the warm spirit of friendliness and devoted service manifested by all of our volunteer workers. Without your help we could not have achieved the success and reputation that has been ours. May you find your reward in the knowledge that thousands of young men enjoyed a ‘home away from home’ in Pittsburgh because of our Canteen.”

Such was the tribute, in part, which Harry H. Schaffer, Chairman of the Army and Navy Service Committee of the Jewish Welfare Board and the “Y”, gave the members of the committee through a letter mailed this week.

At the same time, Mr. Schaffer announced the discontinuance of full Canteen service at the “Y” because of the closing in Pittsburgh of all university army units, and issued to each member of the committee an “honorable discharge” from further volunteer service. The Canteen will be continued on a minimum basis only, from 11:00 a. m. to 8:00 p. m. each Sunday.
