Youth Council For Soviet Jewry Is Formed Here

A Pittsburgh Youth Council for Soviet Jewry has been formed, sponsored by the Jewish Community Relations Council. Gary Cohen, 18-year-old Taylor Alderdice student, has been named Chairman of the council comprised of all organizations and individuals interested in acting on the problems facing Jews in Soviet Russia today.

A protest march has been planned for Sunday, March 3, starting at the Beth Shalom parking lot at 2 p.m., and progressing to Temple Rodef Shalom, in Oakland, where a speaker will be heard. A petition for the rights of Soviet Jews has been drawn up and circulated among all youth organizations in the city.
