Thus far the attendance has averaged nearly 100 per cent. and every child is eager for the Sunday morning session.

The teachers in charge are Miss Essie Rogalsky, Miss Ida Schlanger, Miss Edith Lieberman. They are under the direction of Mrs. A. I. Marx.
