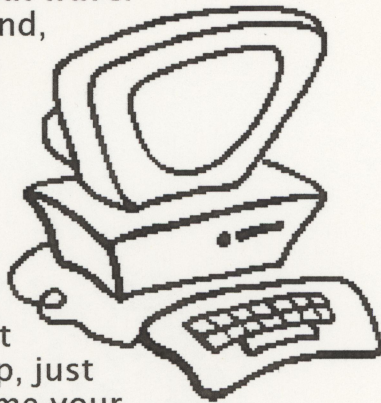


Meet the Board
