
We are a small group, 30 families, who have been meeting for services and sponsoring a Sunday School (28 children). Our people have varied backgrounds, ranging from Conservative through Reform and mixed marriages.

At the present, we hold services in our own homes, and rent a facility for the High Holidays and for weekly Sunday School classes.

We are interested in the financial aspect of having a student Rabbi, and must also know of the limitations (if any) regarding the Rabbi's stay on the week-ends...for example: is Kosher food required and must he stay within walking distance of the place where services will be held?
