At the October 5th meeting of the Synagogue/Federation Relations Committee of the United Jewish Federation of Greater Pittsburgh the subject of the resettlement of South East Asians by the Pittsburgh Jewish community was discussed.

The UJF is preparing to carry out the resettlement of 60 South East Asians at minimal cost. The bulk of the budget is being provided by the U.S. Department of State and is administered by HIAS. Locally, Jewish Family and Children's Service has direct responsibility for this program.

You can help by providing services and/or goods for which we are not budgeted. Specifically, there is a need for children and small sized adult clothing (especially warm clothing), toys and books, linens for bed and bath, window and floor covering. Items should be in good condition and be delivered to Rodef Shalom Temple, Fifth and Morewood, during regular working hours. Please attach your congregation's name, address and an estimated value of the goods so that your contribution can be acknowledged for tax purposes.

Cash contributions would be much appreciated for the purposes of emergency transportation, special personal needs and other required goods.
