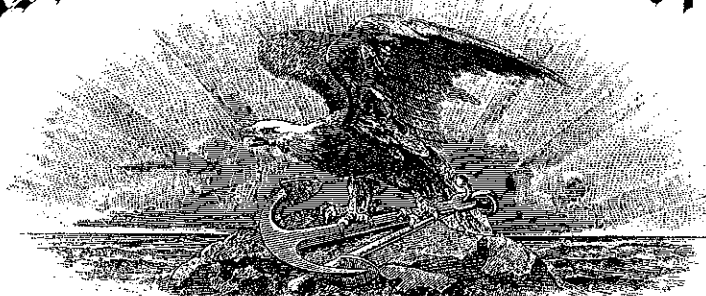

This Commission to continue in force, during the pleasure of the President of the United States, for the time being.

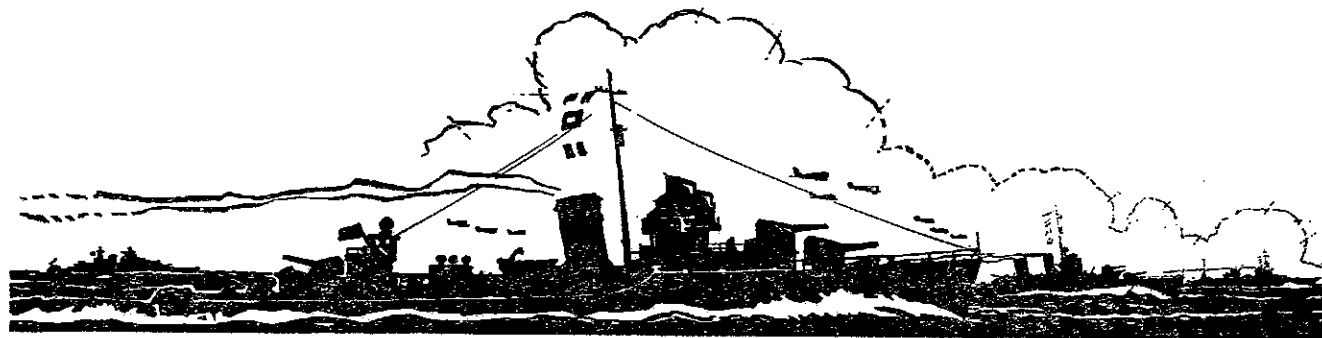

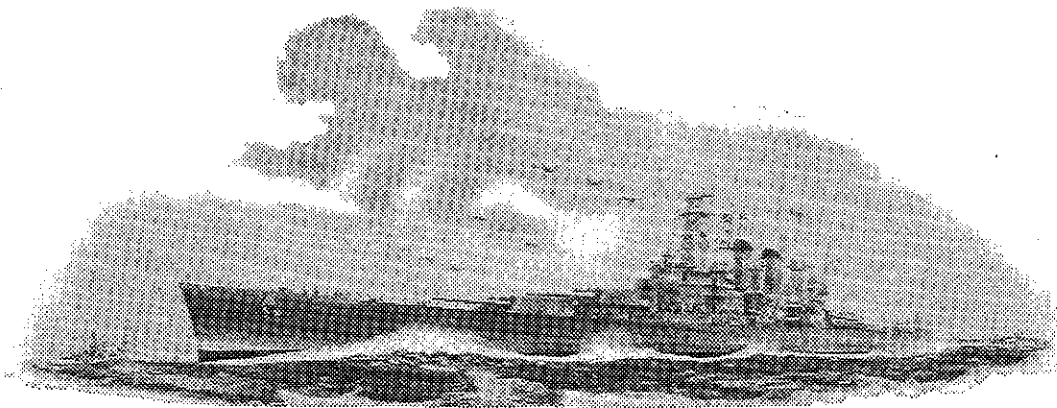
