

A Sisterhood meeting was held in the Synagogue, June 7, presided over by the president Mrs. W. Mary. The minutes were read and approved.

The treasurer, Mrs. J. Rosen, reported that \$197.86, including ~~\$50~~ profit from the B'nai B'rith dinner, was in the treasury.

Following this report, a discussion concerning the cleaning and painting of the Shul was held. It was decided that the Sisterhood should try to undertake the placing of flower urns, cleaning the chandelier, and replacing of bulbs. Mrs. L. Brady was appointed to shop for the urns.

Mrs. W. Mary volunteered to sew new curtains for the school room, and Mrs. A. Heshnick and Mrs. J. Broide were appointed to buy the material. Approximately \$25 was allotted for this project.

Mrs. V. Rosen was then appointed to see that the walls were cleaned

and Mrs. W. Mart offered to shop for linoleum sewing.

The Rabbi sent a message of 'thanks' to the sisterhood for treating the children on June 6. He also suggested that the mothers should alternate in the treating and sewing of the children in order to create more interest among the adults toward Sunday school.

Some social event, such as a lawn fete, was suggested for later in the season but no definite plans were made.
